UN INVESTIMENTO PER IL TUO FUTURO

Humankind is facing grand challenges. “Sustainable Development” is a shorthand for addressing these challenges. While decades of efforts have brought progress in some areas, the overall transformation necessary has not been adequately addressed. Interdisciplinary teamwork is a prerequisite for sustainable development, in particular, if the specific challenges of a region are to be taken into account. To address the challenges of the future, the legacies of the past have to be considered, something which is missing from a lot of sustainability-oriented teaching and research.

From 2013-2015, the University of Trieste in cooperation with Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt and BOKU Vienna (University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences) offers a unique opportunity for young career researchers to familiarize themselves with issues pertinent to the sustainable development of the Danube River Basin. The DIANET INTERNATIONAL SCHOOLS are held in the beautiful town of Gorizia in Italy. In 2013, Interdisciplinary Methods are the core teaching offer. In 2014, the natural heritage of the Danube River Basin will be the focus, followed in 2015 with a focus on cultural heritage. Students and Junior researchers from all countries of the Danube Basin (as represented by the Universities of AARC and DRC) are welcome to apply for one, two or all three schools. The organizing universities will issue a certificate of 3 ECTS for the completion of each school.

In 2013, two full-day excursions to the Upper and Lower Isonzo valley will offer a unique opportunity for students to engage with the sustainability challenges of river basins. Lectures throughout the week will introduce a host of interdisciplinary approaches for dealing with the roles of cultural and natural heritage in sustainable development to students. Teachers will discuss the challenges in a roundtable discussion each afternoon, followed by group work by students. Student groups will identify a project they want to develop throughout the school. Group presentations with direct feedback by faculty will end the experience.

IFF, the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies of Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt, has 30 years of experience with interdisciplinary communication. Their expertise will ensure a truly interdisciplinary, unique experience. Faculty from the universities of AARC and DRC (Trieste, Udine, Primorska, Maribor, Klagenfurt and BOKU Vienna) will ensure that students get up-to-date, place-specific instruction. The school covers a wide range of subjects, from historical geography to geomorphology, from archeobotany to the management of interdisciplinary projects. Students will receive training in methods for the virtual representation of natural resources, as well as historical evidence. The covered methods include architecture and urban development, as well as methods of integration such as environmental history and deal with the preservation of cultural heritage, history and archaeology on a par with natural science methods.

DIANET 2013 can be offered to you at minimal cost, living expenses as well as tuition being covered by the European Social Fund. You might also be eligible for travel assistance by your home university. Applications will be selected by the Organizing Committee, students will be notified by March 15th.

This is a unique opportunity to learn and interact in interdisciplinary groups with a high-level international faculty. English is the only official language of the School.
