



PRELIMINARY NFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS: HOW TO REACH RUSE

The most convenient airport for arrival is Henri Coanda in Bucharest, Romania. The distance between Ruse and Bucharest is 70 km. Other points of arrival can be Sofia (310 km) and Varna (200 km) Airports, Bulgaria. Please, make sure you do **NOT** need another visa for travelling via Romania to Bulgaria. If you do, use the Bulgarian airports in Sofia or Varna.

Arrival in Bucharest

The organizers can arrange taxi transport from Bucharest airport to Ruse. The price for one direction is 42 euros per car and can go down to less than 11 Euro per person when a group of 4 people is formed.













Arrival in Sofia

For those who are flying to Sofia there is a subway connecting Sofia airport and Sofia main bus station from where you can get a bus to Ruse.
